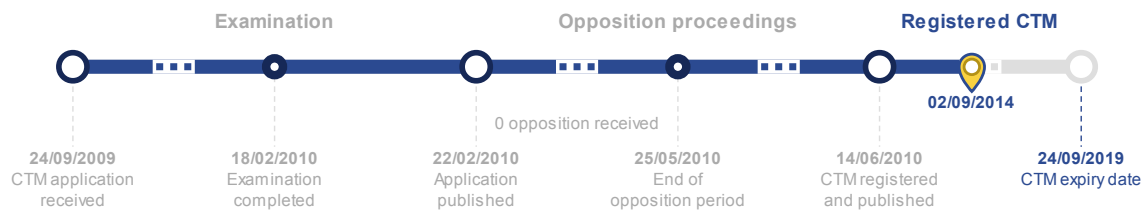

- 3** Cosmetics and perfumery; face paints (make-up); incense; bleaching preparations and other substances for laundry use; cleaning, polishing, scouring and abrasive preparations; soaps, essential oils, hair lotions, dentifrices, sun-tanning preparations (cosmetics).
- 4** Candles for lighting; scented candles; oil (included in class 4); petroleum (raw or refined).
- 5** Plasters materials for dressings; air freshening preparations for rooms and automobiles, non-electric; oils (included in class 5); Pharmaceutical substances, sanitary preparations for medical purposes.
- 6** Articles made from common metals and their alloys; ironmongery, small items of metal hardware; bells, call bells, money boxes of metal; key-rings of common metal.
- 8** Hand operated hand tools; cutlery, including cutlery of plastic; side arms; razors; scissors, tweezers; non-electric can openers; vegetable slicers; Lawn clippers (hand instruments).
- 9** Software, including games software; screensavers and wallpapers for electronic devices (computer software), electronic publications (downloadable), apparatus for recording, transmission or reproduction of sound or images, disposable cameras; magnetic data carriers of all kinds, in particular DVDs, CDs, CD-ROMs; Spectacles, sunglasses; magnetic cards and chip cards, in particular customer cards and bonus cards (included in class 9); helmets; clothing for protection against accidents; decorative magnets; batteries; mobile telephones; data-processing equipment and computers; monitors (computer hardware); Scientific, nautical, surveying, photographic, cinematographic, optical, weighing, measuring, signalling, checking (supervision), life-saving and teaching apparatus and instruments; apparatus and instruments for conducting, switching, transforming accumulating, regulating or controlling electricity; automatic vending machines and mechanisms for coin-operated apparatus; cash registers, calculating machines, fire-extinguishing apparatus; electronic display boards; vacuum gauges; fire sensors; electrical apparatus for sealing plastics (packaging); amusement apparatus adapted for use with an external display screen or monitor (automatic or coin-operated).
- 11** Apparatus for lighting, heating, steam generating, cooking, refrigerating, drying, ventilating, water supply and sanitary purposes; lamps, pocket searchlights, hand-held fans, gas lamps, barbecue starters, air freshening devices for rooms and automobiles (electric); pocket warmers.
- 12** Vehicles; Vehicles for locomotion by air, land or water; Bicycles and tricycles; sun-blinds for automobiles; Child seats for vehicles.
- 14** Precious metals and their alloys and goods in precious metals or coated therewith, not included in other classes, in particular pins (jewellery), medallions, key rings (trinkets or fobs), lanyards, bracelets, tie clips, cuff links, cups and trophies; jewellery, precious stones; horological and chronometric instruments; figurines (statuettes) of precious metal.
- 16** Paper, cardboard and goods made from these materials, included in class 16; printed matter; bookbinding material; photographs; stationery; letters trays and containers and cases for stationery, desk pads, note pads, fill-in tables, calendars, geographical maps, posters, greetings cards, postcards, flags and pennants of paper, bookmarks, transfers, stickers (stationery), drawing pins, paper clips, clips for banknotes, paperweights, writing implements, sharpeners, lids for pens, decorative articles attached to pens and pencils (including rubber erasers), rubber stamps and stamp pads, stapling presses; instructional and teaching material (except apparatus); plastic materials for packaging, included in Class 16; printers' type; printing blocks; figurines (statuettes) of papier-mâché; suitcase labels; identity card sleeves.
- 18** Leather and imitations of leather and goods made from these materials, included in class 18, carry-all bags, sports bags, shopping bags, shoulder bags, rucksacks, small bags, school bags, wallets, belt bags, basketball bags, cases and holdalls, garment bags for travel, umbrellas, parasols and walking sticks; animal collars, leads and harnesses.
- 20** Furniture, mirrors, picture frames, goods, included in class 20, of wood, cork, reed, cane, wicker, horn, bone, ivory, whalebone, shell, amber, mother-of-pearl, meerschaum and substitutes for all these materials, or of plastics; containers of wood or plastic, key boards, protective covers for clothing, coat hangers, cushions, sleeping bags for camping, seats, plastic containers, figurines of wood, wax, plaster or plastic; baskets, not of metal, for pets, packaging containers of plastic; closures, not of metal, for containers; inflatable or rigid promotional articles of plastic.

- 25** Clothing, footwear, headgear.
- 26** Lace and embroidery, ribbons and braid; buttons; zip fasteners; hook and eyes; needles; badges (included in class 26), sewing requisites (included in class 26), sewing thimbles, hair pins, wigs.
- 27** Carpets, rugs, mats and matting, linoleum and other materials for covering existing floors; wall hangings (non-textile); car mats, tapestries (not of textile); floor coverings for existing floors.
- 28** Games and playthings; soft toys; foam hands, toy snow globes, toys for domestic pets, amusement apparatus, not adapted for use with an external display screen or monitor (automatic or coin-operated); gymnastic and sporting articles (included in class 28); balls for games, basketball baskets and nets and frames and wall mounts.

- 32** Beers; mineral and aerated waters and other non-alcoholic drinks; fruit drinks and fruit juices; syrups and other preparations for making beverages; isotonic beverages; vegetable juices.
- 34** Tobacco; smokers' articles; matches; lighters; ashtrays.
