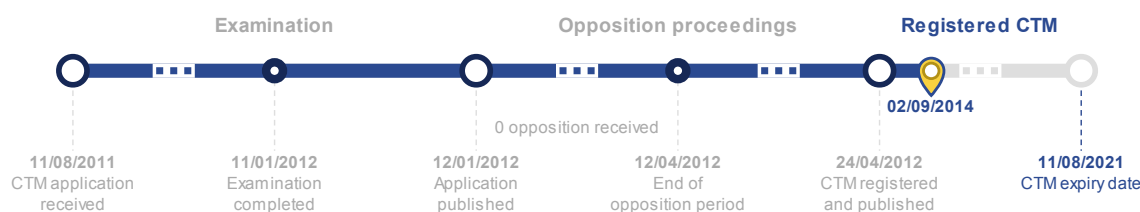

1 Films sensitized but not exposed (unexposed); chemicals used in science and/or photography; tanning substances; artificial sweeteners; chemical products for industrial use; chemical products for use in industry and/or in manufacturing processes; synthetic materials for absorbing oil; detergent additives for motor fuel; chemical additives for motor fuel, for lubricants and for greases; adhesives for use in industry; antifreeze; brake fluids; clutch fluids; brazing products; degreasers used in manufacturing processes; oil dispersants; fluids for hydraulic circuits; welding chemicals; transmission fluids; liquid coolants; chemical products for the treatment of cooling systems; cooling products for cutting fluids; dehumidifying fluids; all for industrial use; chemicals used agriculture, horticulture and forestry; unprocessed artificial resins, unprocessed plastics; manures; fire extinguishing compositions; tempering and soldering preparations; chemical substances for preserving foodstuffs.
